POWERS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE BOARD

- 1.0 Exercise all “Powers of School Boards ” as established in state statute, those powers which shall include, but not be limited to, the provisions of this policy.
- 2.0 Acts as a legislative body to formulate and review policies, approve rules and regulations, and oversee the sound administration of the District.
- 3.0 Determines the salaries of all staff not covered as part of a collective bargaining unit.
- 4.0 Is responsible for compliance with the Law.
- 5.0 Appoints the number of commissioners required by the supervisory union (SU) board as representatives of the District Board.
- 6.0 Considers and adopts curricula.
- 7.0 After considering the recommendation of the superintendent, shall employ such persons as may be required to carry out the work of the District and dismiss any employee when necessary.
- 8.0 In consultation with the superintendent, develops and adopts an annual budget and monitors compliance.
- 9.0 Enforces compliance with the Law regarding the safe operation of the school district.
- 10.0 Enters into negotiations with appropriate collective bargaining units to establish contracts.
- 11.0 Is responsible for the expulsion of students according to due process as defined by Board policy.

12.0 Is responsible for overseeing the maintenance of the school building and property.

13.0 Strives to provide every student with the opportunity for an education of the highest attainable quality.
