

EVALUATION OF SUPERINTENDENT

The Superintendent serves as the chief executive of the U-61 Supervisory Union, executes the policies of the district, and supervises the execution of laws relating to the district.

The Superintendent serves as the U61 liaison to other agencies and the community promoting the educational goals and objectives identified by the district. This person oversees personnel matters, curriculum and assessment development and implementation, facilities maintenance and use, and fiscal planning and budgeting.

Statement of Evaluation Policy

It is the responsibility of the Board to maintain and improve the quality of administration and instruction. One of the primary methods used in carrying out this responsibility is to work with the Superintendent in improving his or her effectiveness. In this regard, the Board may formally contribute to the evaluation by completing a form listing strengths, areas of improvement, and recommendations for change. The Board shall convene in an Executive Session to discuss the evaluation of the Superintendent. The Board Chair shall compile the verbal and written contributions to present to the Supervisory Union Board.
