1. Promote public interest and participation in the operation of the school system.
2. Provide an honest, continuous, comprehensive flow of information about policies, procedures, programs, needs, problems and progress of the school system to the community.
3. Develop and maintain the good will, respect and confidence of the public with regard to the school board, the school staff and the services provided.
4. Ascertain the public's attitudes toward educational issues and discover the public's aspirations for the education of all children.
5. Anticipate and provide information to the public concerning problems that are brought about by misinformation or a lack of understanding.
6. Provide a planned, systematic, two-way process of communication between the school district and the public.
